DEMAND FOR DISCOVERY

The Defendant, LINDSEY BROOKE ISAACS, hereby gives notice of her election to participate in discovery in this matter under Fla. R. Crim. P. 3.220, and requests the following from the prosecution within 15 days:

1. The names and addresses of all persons known to the prosecutor to have information that may be relevant to any offense charged or any defense thereto, or to any similar fact evidence to be presented at trial under section 90.404(2), Florida Statutes. The witnesses should be clearly designated as required by Fla. R. Crim. P. 3.220(b)(1)(A).
2. Statements of any persons named above, including written reports of law enforcement officers.
3. Statements made by the Defendant.
4. Statements of any co-defendants.
5. Recorded grand jury minutes containing testimony of the Defendant.
6. Tangible papers or objects that were obtained from or belonged to the Defendant.
7. Whether the state has any material or information that has been provided by an informant.
8. Whether there has been any electronic surveillance of the Defendant and any documents relating thereto.
9. Whether there has been any search and seizure and any documents relating thereto.
10. Reports or statements of experts made in connection with this case, including results of physical or mental exams and scientific tests, experiments or comparisons.
11. Any tangible papers or objects that the prosecution intends to use in the hearing or trial that were not obtained from or did not belong to the Defendant.
12. Any tangible paper, objects or substances in the possession of law enforcement that could be

tested for DNA.

13. All video or other photographic evidence of the Defendant.
