MOTION FOR PRETRIAL DETENTION

COMES NOW R.J. LARIZZA, State Attorney of the Seventh Judicial Circuit of Florida, by and through the undersigned Assistant State Attorney, pursuant to Fla.R.Crim.P. 3.132 and s. 907.041, Fla. Stat., moves this Honorable Court to enter an Order detaining the Defendant in custody pending a final hearing on Pretrial Detention, and sets forth with particularity the grounds and essential facts, as follows:

1. The defendant is charged with:
 - a. Leaving the Scene of a Crash with a Death
 - b. Leaving the Scene of a Crash with a Death
 - c. Leaving the Scene of a Crash with a Death
 - d. Leaving the Scene of a Crash with Serious Bodily Injury
 - e. Vehicular Manslaughter
 - f. Vehicular Manslaughter
 - g. Vehicular Manslaughter
 - h. Reckless Driving Causing Serious Bodily Injury

2. The defendant is charged with a dangerous crimes, Vehicular Manslaughter, Vehicular Manslaughter, Vehicular Manslaughter and that there is a substantial probability that the defendant has committed the

offense; and that no conditions of release will reasonably assure the defendant's appearance at subsequent criminal proceedings;

3. The defendant poses the threat of harm to the community: The defendant is presently charged with a dangerous crimes, to wit: Vehicular Manslaughter x 3 counts.
4. That there is a substantial probability that the defendant committed such crime, based on the defendant's past and present patterns of behavior, consideration of the criteria in s. 903.046, and any other relevant facts, that no conditions of release or bail will reasonably protect the community from risk of physical harm, ensure the presence of the defendant at trial, or insure the integrity of the judicial process
5. The Defendant was the cause of the multi vehicle crash resulting in the death of three people and serious bodily injury to another survivor. The Defendant was seen on video in the Orlando area leaving a smoke shop at a particular time that would place her at the scene of the crash traveling on I4. Independent eyewitness accounts have the vehicle that the defendant was operating in caused a multi vehicle crash and left the scene. The eyewitness testimony of the 2020 Dodge Durango "street racing/track" edition driving recklessly through traffic, colliding with a motorcycle and a car at excessive speeds, and then quickly left the scene of a crash resulting in death and serious bodily injury. The defendant was found at her apartment and made multiple claims about being set up, being framed, and other implausible scenarios that factually did not support her claims.
6. The defendant is a danger to the community.
7. See the 707 which is attached and hereby incorporated by this reference for the essential facts.

The undersigned Assistant State Attorney certifies that sworn testimony under oath supports the grounds and essential facts alleged in this motion.

WHEREFORE, the State, by and through the undersigned Assistant State Attorney, respectfully moves this Honorable Court to grant this motion and order the defendant to remain in custody on pretrial detention with no bond.
